How much water should my horse be drinking?

With colder temperatures in the Winter season, knowing how much water your horse should be drinking is important. The average-sized adult horse



will drink between **4-9 gallons per day**. If you notice your horse's water intake is decreased during the cooler months, offering a bucket of water with a scoop of electrolytes can stimulate your horse to drink – but always offer your horse a pure source of water in addition to the electrolytes!
